The Planning Commission:

- Consists of 5 members, appointed by the Mayor, with concurrence from the majority of the City Council, for 4 year terms.
- Meetings are held on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month at 7:00 p.m.

Duties include:

- Review new commercial, industrial and residential uses; and
- Recommend the City Council General Plan Amendments, Zone Changes and zoning rules that regulate certain uses.

Minimum qualifications include:

- At least 18 years of age;
- El Monte resident for at least 1 year; and
- Bachelor's degree and/or at least 5 years of professional experience in the fields of real estate, engineering, architecture, public administration, urban planning or construction management.
