

## RFP for On-Call Environmental Consulting Services Release of Information Requested

Posted February 20, 2020

Q: How long is the On-Call contract for?

A: Approximately 3-5 years.

Q: If we want to provide multiple service Tasks, but not all of the Tasks, do we need to submit multiple proposals (e.g. one proposal for Task 1, and one proposal for Task 3), or just one proposal listing all of the Tasks where we want to provide services to the City?

A: One proposal listing all tasks consultant intends to provide.

Q: Are we able to submit qualifications to provide only cultural resources and tribal cultural resources? These services would support Tasks 1-8.

A: The City is seeking qualifications for comprehensive CEQA services.

Q: Is this opportunity for an On-Call Qualified Consultants List only? Or will it be an On Call Master Services Agreement Contract (where in the case of the latter, you set up a contract for each consultant, then issue brief Requests for Bids (RFBs) to some or all of your “bench” of consultants)?

A: It will be an opportunity for on-call consultants list.

Q: Whether a List or a Contract, how many firms do you anticipate selecting?

A: Multiple firms.

Q: How many specific upcoming projects are you aware of that will require NEPA consulting?

A: At this time, there is at least one project that may require NEPA consulting in the future.

Q: Will you be posting Q&A periodically between now and February 10<sup>th</sup>? *(This is helpful for firms who may be waiting for an answer before deciding whether to pursue.)*

Or will you wait until the afternoon of February 10<sup>th</sup> then post everything at once? *(This is helpful for firms who want to get started right away.)*

A: Staff will answer questions and answers as they are received, up until February 10, 2020.
